The home utilises the "Teaching Family Model", an evidence based therapeutic model widely delivered overseas and in several of our services. It is effective in teaching young people to improve their behaviours and to build brighter futures. Full training in the Teaching Family Model is provided.

As live-in Teaching Parents you will provide care for up to 5 young men aged 12-16 years with challenging behaviour. You will be responsible for the day-to-day household management of a Youth Horizons residential home and manage a team of support staff.

***Each young person needs:***

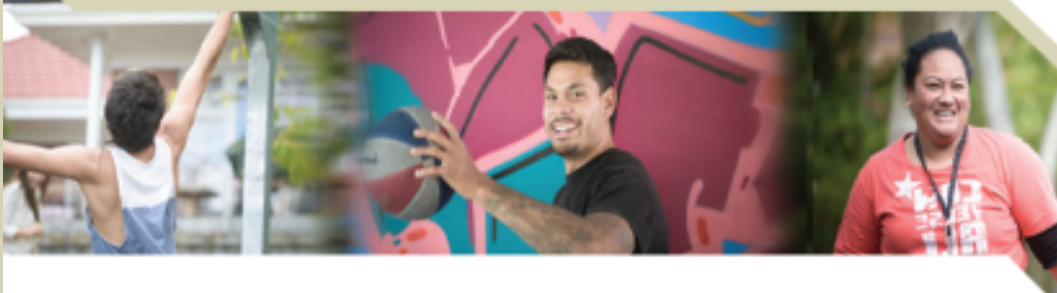
- Your well-honed parenting or interpersonal skills so each can thrive

- To be safe and secure, accepted for who they are and treated with respect

The position is live-in, with a separate bedroom and bathroom for the Teaching Parents. We provide 24x7 support including active, on-site support from the Practice Leader and in-home staff support. Our skilled clinical and cultural team will work with you to address the young people's behaviours.

The remuneration package includes a salary for each parent plus food and normal household expenses and a vehicle for work related travel.
